**\*IMPORTANT:** A registration deposit of \$100 is due at the time of registration. Hebrew tuition, if applicable, will be charged to your Beth Am account. Your total tuition balance of Judaica plus Hebrew (if applicable) minus the deposit paid will appear on your Beth Am statement.

**Camp Newman Retreats:** All students in 3<sup>rd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade are encouraged to attend retreats at URJ Camp Newman in Santa Rosa, including Fall Kallah (3<sup>rd</sup>–5<sup>th</sup> grade) or West Coast Party, Jr. (for 6<sup>th</sup>–8<sup>th</sup> grade). Beth Am provides a discounted registration fee for those who attend.

**A Note about Tuition:** The actual costs to run our youth education programs are only partially covered by tuition fees. The remaining portion is subsidized out of the congregation's operating budget. Families in financial difficulty are granted scholarships so that their children can participate in our youth education programs.
