Education Program Traffic Guidelines

Our greatest concern is our students' health and safety.
We need your help!

We are working hard to improve pick-up and drop-off procedures in order to make Beth Am as safe as possible for our children and ourselves.

Please read the following guidelines.

1. If you are able to park and walk, please park in the parking lot to your right as you drive into campus. You can walk to the designated pick up space to find your child(ren).
2. Please remember that our road is one lane only.
3. Students may only be picked up at the designated pick up space next to the Conference Room and the Front Office.
4. Please do not stop, park, load, or wait at the top of the horseshoe for 15 minutes before and after and during program hours.
5. There are carpool lists for you to pick up in the Education Office.
6. If you would like to volunteer for traffic duty, please contact your student's teacher or youthed@betham.org.

We would like to remind you that...

- A. The only designated pick up location is at the end of the breezeway near the Conference Room and the Front Office. **No other location is authorized for pick up.** If this pick up location is inconvenient for you, please feel free to park in either of the lower parking lots and walk to the pick up location.
- B. Teachers send our students to the pick up location after programs end. Hebrew Program ends at 6pm for Tzavta classes and 5:30pm for all other classes. Sunday Program ends at 11:15am. Tuesday Night Program concludes at 8:15pm.
- C. The pick up location is well-lit and supervised for 15 minutes after programs end. 15 minutes after a program ends staff brings all remaining students to the Education Office.
- D. If you cannot find your child(ren) during pick up, after checking the pick up space, please go directly to the Education Office.
- E. **Please do not drop off your students in any location other than the authorized drop off location,** at the end of the breezeway near the Chapel and the BATY room.

F. **Our speed limit is 15 mph** – only if road conditions are clear. If there is a traffic jam, please drive as slowly as necessary to ensure everyone's safety.

Program Specific Instructions:

Sunday Program

Every class of each grade assigned to traffic duty needs at least 2 volunteers for drop off and 2 for pick up. You can sign up with your child(ren)'s teacher or in the Education Office for traffic duty.

Before Program Traffic Duty means going to the Ed Office at 8:45am to pick up vests & signs and standing at the 'drop off' space to ensure people actually drop off their students there. Additional volunteers should cover the top of the horseshoe.

After Program Traffic Duty means going to the Ed Office at 11am to pick up vests & signs and going to the pick up place to make sure kids are safe. Additional volunteers should cover the top of the horseshoe (no stopping or loading). Also, at pick up, we need volunteers at the drop off space for confused drivers. At 11:30am, please bring any students to the Education Office.

Even if you have not signed up, you are welcome to help.

Tuesday Night Program

At 8:30pm, please bring any students to the Education Office.
