

Beth Am 4th & 5th Grade Retreat FAQs

Q. Who can go?

A. All 4th and 5th grade students are welcome to attend the retreat regardless of whether they are registered in a Beth Am Youth Program!

Q. Why should I go?

A. Our Beth Am Youth Retreat is part of our education programs and is a wonderful chance to build great memories with Beth Am staff and dozens of friends, to share in the experience of prayer and learning, and enjoy original programs that will make you laugh and learn.

Q. What will we be doing?

A. We will be doing a variety of fun and exciting programs based on the theme of “*What’s God got to do with me?*” We will enjoy meals together, as well as share in the joy of Shabbat. There will be fun art projects, as well as opportunities for sports and hiking. There will also be plenty of free time to hang out with your friends.

Q. Will both groups be together the whole time?

A. We are running 2 retreats concurrently. The 4th -5th Grade Retreat participants and the 6th – 8th Grade Retreat participants will be together during services and meals. Programs and cabin assignments will be by grade.

Q. I usually have lots of homework - can I still come?

A. There is time set aside for free time on Saturday afternoon as well as at night in the cabins, so if needed you can do your homework then. You will be home by noon on Sunday, so you will also have time to do homework on Sunday afternoon.

Q. What should I pack?

A. Everyone should pack plenty of WARM CLOTHES!! Although it may be warm or hot during the day, the nights get fairly cold. We may have wet weather. It is advised to bring warm layers: jackets, hats, extra socks, etc. We also recommend that everyone pack at least one extra pair of sneakers, in case of rain!!! - Bed linens are **NOT** provided, so everyone needs to bring a sleeping bag and pillow. You should also pack other personal items, such as shower shoes (i.e. flip flops), shampoo, soap, toothpaste, flashlight, towel, etc.
- Please **DO NOT** bring the following: open-toed shoes, money or valuables, candy or snacks. There will be plenty of snacks throughout the weekend!!!

Q. What if I need to come late or leave early?

A. In order to ensure participant safety, build community, and to make the retreat experience as meaningful as possible, full participation – from beginning to end – is necessary. The Youth Retreat is packed FULL of activities so we don't want you to miss out on any of it! If you cannot attend the entire retreat, please contact Shaina Wasserman at (650) 493-4665. We may be able to create alternate arrangements for you.

Q. What if my child takes medications?

A. We will make sure your child get their medication as per your doctor's orders. Please bring any medication they take regularly or in case of any other conditions, such as asthma or allergic reactions. To ensure that each person receives the right medication at the right time **ALL** medications will be held by Retreat Staff. Medications will be collected at the bus check-in and returned when we return to Beth Am on Sunday. If your child will be bringing medication, please make sure to include the necessary information on the Emergency Information section of the Registration form.

Q. What if I want to stay in a cabin with my friends?

A. If you have other friends who are in the same grade as you, please put down all of their names on the appropriate line on the registration form. We cannot guarantee that you can be with all of your choices but we will do our best to accommodate your requests.

Q. I have turned in my registration forms, how do I know if I am going on the retreat?

A. You will receive a confirmation by email approx. 3-4 days after your registration forms have been received. If your forms are received after the February 12th deadline we will do our best to guarantee you a space and you will receive an email confirmation informing you of our availability.
